This month we have two opportunities: A lunch time webinar on the phase out of existing refrigerants and The Future of Refrigerants by Philip Johnston, PEng with an evening Q&A session hosted by Craig Rohwer of Trane & Zach Keller of Stinebaugh & Company. Come discuss where the industry is heading and what to expect for new refrigerants in your **HVACR** applications.
